| vi file | Edits <i>file</i> . |
|------------------------------|--|
| $\mathbf{vi} + n \ file$ | Edits <i>file</i> , cursor at line n . |
| $\mathbf{vi} + file$ | Edits <i>file</i> , cursor at end. |
| vi -r | List system saved files. |
| vi -r <i>file</i> | Edits system saved <i>file</i> . |
| vi file | Edits first <i>file</i> ; rest via :n. |
| \mathbf{vi} -t tag | Edits file through tag in tags file. |
| \mathbf{vi} +/pattern file | Edits file, cursor at <i>pattern</i> . |
| view file | vi <i>file</i> , no modification. |
| ZZ | Exits from vi , saving changes. |
| ^Z | Stops vi for later resumption. |

| Last line | Error messages, echoing input to commands: /, | ?, :, !, feed- |

| | back about I/O and large changes. | |
| © lines | On screen only, not in file. | |
| ~ lines | Lines past end of file. | |
| \hat{x} | Control characters. | |
| TABs | Expands to spaces, cursor on last space. | |

Counts before vi Commands

| Line/column no. | z, G, |
|------------------|------------|
| Scroll amount | ^D, ^U |
| Replicate insert | a, i, A, I |
| Repeat effect | Most rest |

Vi States

| Command mode | Executes commands; the normal and initial state. Other modes return to command mode. ESC cancels a partial command. |
|--------------|---|
| Insert mode | Entered by a, i, A, I, o, O, c, C, s, S, R, followed by arbitrary text terminated by ESC. An interrupt aborts an insertion. |
| Last line | Reads user input for commands /, ?, :, !, which ter- minates in ESC or RETURN. An interrupt aborts. |

Basic Commands

| dw | Deletes a word. |

| de | Deletes a word leaving punctuation. |
| dd | Deletes a line. |
| 3dd | Deletes three lines. |
| d% | Deletes to matching parenthesis/bracket |
| i <i>text</i> ESC cw <i>text</i> ESC ea <i>s</i> ESC xp | Inserts <i>text</i> Changes word to <i>text</i> Pluralizes word. Transposes characters. |

Interrupting, Cancelling, Shell Interaction

| ESC | Ends insert, input, or incomplete command. |
|------------|---|
| ^ ? | (DELETE) interrupts vi . |
| ^Z | Suspends vi $(csh \text{ and } ksh)$. |
| :sh | Runs default Shell, then returns. |
| : ! cmd | Runs Shell-level <i>cmd</i> , then returns. |

File Manipulation

| :w | Writes back changes. |

| :wq | Writes and quits from vi . |
| :q | Quits from vi . |
| :q! | Quits, discards changes. |
| :e file | Edits <i>file</i> . |
| :e! | Reedits, discards changes. |

| :e + file | Edits <i>file</i> , starting at the end. |

| :e + n file | Edits file starting at line n . |
| :w file | Writes to <i>file</i> . |
